There is no cost to enter. Entries will be capped at a total of 50 to allow for display spacing throughout the fairgrounds. Submitting your application does not guarantee you will be chosen. Entries are juried to avoid theme duplication and assure display balance. You will be notified of acceptance or rejection within one week of submission of this entry form.

- All costs incurred to create the display are the responsibility of the entrant.
- The fairgrounds will be supplying electricity for each display at no cost. Entrants must provide a heavy duty grounded electrical cord/s to connect for power.
- · No inflatable decorations or pop up tents will be permitted
- All display items must be tied down and secured to either a wagon, platform or anchor. (Wood pallets are recommended for anchoring all items. Entrants are responsible for the maintenance of their display throughout the event. In the case maintenance is needed a member of the organizing committee will phone the entrant and make arrangements for entrant to make repairs.

Breakdown and removal after the event is the responsibility of the entrant. Breakdown and removal will take place Sunday, December 14th, 9am - 1pm Cash Prizes: Every attendee to the event will receive a ballot to vote for their favorite display. Ballots will be collected upon exit and tallies will be done at the end of the three-weekend event. Prizes will be in two

categories individuals and business entries. And will be as follows:
